PLASTIC BOTTLES #1 AND #2 ONLY



All Beverage bottles (opening narrower than the base)

All Detergent bottles (such as dishwasher soap bottles)

All Other bottles that are not hazardous waste

No clear egg, berry, or lettuce containers, or clear clamshells

No semi-opaque pint and quart containers from the deli (please reuse)

No butter tubs or yogurt containers

No nursery plant packs or flats (even if they ARE labeled #1 or #2).

No #5 - #7 plastics, of any kind! **No** bottle tops!

CO-MINGLED PAPER:



All Newspapers (need not be bundled and tied)

All White office paper and junk mail (need not be in paper bags)

All Corrugated cardboard (should be broken down, need not be tied)

All Chipboard -- such as cereal boxes (liners should be removed)

All Milk and juice cartons (rinsed), plastic spouts removed

DPW only:

Proper recyclables **ONLY** may also be deposited in the dumpsters at the Borough Garage by residents only. Household batteries, tires, used motor oil and antifreeze and used ink jet cartridges are collected at the Borough Garage. **Please read the signs for appropriate disposal areas.**
