Doug has been the head Sailing Coach at Drexel University since 2010. He is a certified US Sailing Level 2 Instructor. Prior to coaching at Drexel, Doug was head sailing coach at Monmouth University. Doug is the lead instructor at Hunterdon Sailing Club learn to sail program and the club's Junior Sailing Team Coach. His team has produced two Midget North America Champions and the top US sailor at the Junior North America Championship in 2011.

Derek Jackson

Derek is the current US Sunfish Class President. He is the winner of numerous regional regattas and has been a top 5 finisher at both the North American and World Championships. He has taught sailing and racing to numerous groups of both juniors and adults.

Sue Brown

Sue is the current US Sunfish Class Regatta Coordinator. She is a lead instructor at Hunterdon Sailing Club's learn to sail program as well as a frequent presenter at sailing seminars throughout New Jersey.

Alec Manson

To participate, all sailors must have experience in sailing a Sunfish single handed and be competent swimmers. Each participant's guardian will be asked to sign a release form at registration. There is a \$15 entry fee for each racer. To participate an individual must not have reached his or her 19th birthday by the end of 2012. All sailors must wear USCG approved personal flotation devices at all times when on the water.
